**Project Overview:** The project focused on enhancing fire safety at Thomas Willingale School by addressing issues with outdated and non-compliant fire doors. As a critical element of the school's fire strategy, the work aimed to bring the fire doors up to current standards, ensuring the safety of staff and students in the event of an emergency.

**Scope of Work:** SDE Contracts Ltd was tasked with implementing BM Trada-approved repair techniques on over 40 existing fire doors, addressing issues such as door gaps, glazing, and intumescent strips to meet current compliance standards. In addition, nine door sets were replaced with BM Trada-certified FD30S products to provide enhanced fire protection and align with the school's updated fire strategy. The project required close coordination with the school to minimize disruption.

**Design and Programme Management:** The school's motto, "Capable of Anything," resonated throughout the project as the work presented challenges due to the age of the building and previous piecemeal replacements. SDE managed the programme with precision, carrying out all works during school breaks to avoid disrupting daily operations. Effective communication and collaboration with school staff ensured that safety and operational considerations were maintained throughout the process.

**Handover and Post-Completion:** The project was completed successfully with all repairs and replacements fully certified to BM Trada standards. The upgrades significantly improved the fire safety infrastructure, providing peace of mind for the entire school community.
